Who we are?

Stockholms Sjukhem is a private non-profit organization and health care provider, owned and operated by a foundation founded in 1867.

The organization provide high-quality care in a number of areas: Advanced Home Care and Palliative Care, Geriatric Care, Primary Care, Rehabilitation, and Eldery Care (nursing home).

Brommageriatriken as a part of Stockholms Sjukhem is one of the largest geriatric clinics in Sweden. The clinic provides acute geriatric healthcare and rehabilitation mainly for the inhabitants of the western suburbs of Stockholm.

Our core operation skills as a geriatric hospital is essentially specific expertise and knowledge regarding taking care of elderly patients suffering from multiple diseases as well as functional impairments.

Your duties and qualifications!

The treatment is carried out in team based units where you as a nurse take active responsibility to cater for the patient safe nursing. Together with assistant nurse, doctors and paramedical personnel you ensure good care and rehabilitation conditions with the patient and their relatives in the centre.

Your work with patients involves treatment and care giving activities, share medication, documentation according to relevant law, guidelines and specific care-giving tasks for nurses in the wards.

We are looking for EU/EES registered nurses, ideally with proven experience.

- You are secure in your nurse role and used to deal with acute, diverse and varied tasks.

- Wants to be part of a care team which see challenges as opportunities that are encountered on a daily basis.
- As a person, you are responsible, used to make independent decisions and is distinctly cooperative.

Terms of employment?

You will initially be placed in a ward with Department manager and Head doctor originating from Greece.
